Democratic State Committee Reorganizational Meeting

Saturday, April 4, 2020

Meeting Minutes

Massachusetts Democratic Party Chairman Gus Bickford called the meeting to order at 10:14 a.m.

The Chair then reviewed the check-in and balloting process, Zoom controls and rules of engagement. The Chair reviewed the agenda of the meeting, including the election of Add-On members to the Committee, the election of officers, and any new business. The Chair explained that only ballot and caucus-elected members, 20 year members, and ex-officio members are able to vote for Add-On members, and that only members that have completed the check-in form will receive ballots. Uncontested seats would be voted on by acclamation, and the full committee would then elect officers: two vice-chairs, a treasurer, secretary, and four deputy treasurers.

The Chair introduced candidate speeches. The Chair then explained that Add-On candidates would have one minute each to speak, and that the order of the speeches was determined by coin flip prior to the meeting. The Chair invited Affirmative Action candidates to speak first, beginning with male seats, and said that ballots would be after the completion of Affirmative Action female candidate speeches.

The Chair then introduced the 24 candidates for the 19 Affirmative Action male Add-On seats¹ individually in alphabetical order and each candidate delivered their one minute speech.

At the conclusion of the Affirmative Action male speeches, the Chair introduced the 21 candidates for the 12 Affirmative Action female Add-On seats² individually in reverse alphabetical order and each candidate delivered their one minute speech.

At 11:12 a.m. the Chair sent out the first ballot, to elect Affirmative Action Add-On members, to the Committee via email. The Chair reminded members that they must be checked-in to the meeting to receive a ballot, and that they may only vote once. The Chair then indicated that members would have until 11:45 a.m. to complete and submit their ballot.

The Chair then invited candidates for College male Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 3 candidates for the 2 seats³ individually in reverse alphabetical order and each candidate delivered their one minute speech.

Next, the Chair invited candidates for Disability male Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 4 candidates for the 3 seats⁴ individually in alphabetical order and each candidate delivered their one minute speech.

The Chair then invited candidates for Disability female Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 4 candidates for the 3 seats⁵ individually in alphabetical order and each candidate delivered their one minute speech.

Following the disability female speeches, the Chair invited candidates for Gay Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 7 candidates for the 5 seats⁶ individually in reverse alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

The Chair then invited candidates for Labor male Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 7 candidates for the 5 seats⁷ individually in reverse alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

At the conclusion of these speeches at 11:46, the Chair announced that the first ballot to elect Affirmative Action Add-Ons was closed and reminded the Committee that the next ballot would

be sent after the conclusion of the second round of speeches. The Chair then invited candidates for Portuguese-Speaking male Add-On seat to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 2 candidates for the seat⁸ individually in alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

The Chair next invited candidates for the Veteran female Add-On seat to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 2 candidates for the seat⁹ individually in reverse alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

The Chair then invited candidates for the Youth male Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 6 candidates for the 4 seats¹⁰ individually in alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

Lastly, the Chair invited candidates for the Gender Balance Add-On seats to deliver their speeches. The Chair introduced the 17 candidates for the 11 seats¹¹ individually in reverse alphabetical order and the candidates delivered their speeches.

The Chair then sent out the second ballot to elect College male, Disability male, Disability female, Gay, Labor male, Portuguese-Speaking male, Veteran female, Youth male, and Gender Balance Add-On members to and informed the Committee the ballot would remain open until 12:50 p.m. The Chair then announced the winners of the 19 Affirmative Action female seats¹² and 19 Affirmative Action male seats¹³.

At 12:23 the Chair invited candidates for Add-On seats running for uncontested seats to deliver speeches while balloting continued¹⁴. Following these speeches, Executive Director Veronica Martinez recognized Brenda Brathwaite and Charlotte Golar-Richie to update the Committee on their work on the JFK Scholarship Committee. Brathwaite shared that the deadline for

applications had been extended to April 14th, and asked that members share the information with their networks.

The Chair then recognized Rules Committee chair Bill Eddy to preview the motion to cancel the 2020 State Convention that would be made after the officers election. Eddy stated that to hold 30 percent of caucuses virtually would hold those caucuses to a different standard than the 70 percent held in-person. Eddy said that the issue of fairness led to their recommendation to cancel the 2020 State Convention. Eddy then explained that the motion would also instruct the Chair to request that Secretary of State William Galvin place both Senator Ed Markey and Congressman Joe Kennedy III on the Democratic primary ballot for the U.S. Senate.

The Chair recognized Jim Roosevelt to speak on the decision by the DNC to move the Democratic National Convention. Roosevelt explained that the decision to move the convention to August 17th-20th, was in the interest of keeping everyone safe and that the DNC still plans to move forward with the Convention, but will make adjustments as the situation develops.

At 12:50 p.m. the Chair announced that the second ballot had closed. The Chair then reviewed the caucus by mail process to elect delegates to the Democratic National Convention. The Chair explained that Massachusetts Democrats would have until April 22nd to request a ballot from the MassDems. The MassDems would then mail ballots mailed on April 24th, and voters would have until May 4th to return their ballots.

The Chair then announced the winners of the College male, Disability male, Disability female, Gay, Labor male, Portuguese-Speaking male, Veteran female, Youth male, and Gender Balance Add-On seats¹⁵.

At 1:13 the Chair began the nominations of officers. The Chair recognized Sandi Bagley who nominated Debra Kozikowski for the female vice-chair office. Jim Roosevelt seconded the nomination. The Chair called for other nominations, and hearing none, closed the floor to nominations. Ervin Russell made a motion to elect Kozikowski by acclamation. The motion was seconded, and Debra Kozikowski was elected Vice-Chair of the Committee by acclamation.

The Chair then recognized Mark DiSalvo to nominate Leon Brathwaite for the male Vice-Chair position. Melvin Poindexter seconded the nomination. Valentino Capobianco made a motion to

close nominations, the motion was seconded by Louis Elisa, and the motion passed. Elisa made a motion to elect Leon Brathwaite by acclamation, it was seconded by Daniel Manning, and the motion was passed.

The Chair then asked Debra Kozokowski to serve as Chair for the election of Treasurer, who then recognized Paul Yorkis to make a nomination. Yorkis nominated Ambassador Rufus Gifford, Gus Bickford seconded the nomination. A motion was made to close nominations, the motion was seconded and passed. A motion was made to elect Ambassador Gifford Treasurer by acclamation, the motion was seconded and passed.

Debra Kozikowski then recognized Jim DiTullio, who nominated Carol Aloisi for Secretary. Mark DiSalvo and Kate Donaghue seconded the nomination. Marilyn Pettito Devaney made a motion to close nominations, the motion was seconded and passed. A motion was made to elect Aloisi by acclamation, the motion was seconded, and passed.

Debra Kozikowski asked Leon Brathwaite to serve as Chair for the election of Deputy Treasurers. Brathwaite recognized Gus Bickford, who nominated Sharon Stout, Kathy Gasperine, Tom Holloway, and Mike Lake. The nominations were seconded, and a motion was made to close nominations. The motion was seconded and passed. A motion was made to elect Stout, Gasperine, Holloway, and Lake by acclamation, the motion was seconded and passed.

The Chair announced that the Committee was now fully reorganized. The Chair then reviewed the proposal to cancel the 2020 State Convention. The Chair discussed the options to hold caucuses virtually and postpone the Convention, citing that those options would call the fairness of the caucuses into question and that the Convention could not be postponed due to deadlines set by the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

The Chair recognized Bill Eddy, who made a motion to cancel the 2020 State Convention in Lowell and instruct the Chair to request that the Secretary of the Commonwealth place the names of both Senator Ed Markey and Congressman Joe Kennedy III on the Democratic primary ballot for the U.S. Senate. Martina Jackson seconded the motion. After discussion, Jay Rivera made a motion to call it to question, Rhonda Bourne seconded, and the motion passed. The Committee unanimously voted to cancel the 2020 State Convention.

The Chair then reviewed the caucus by mail process to elect delegates to the Democratic National Convention. Bill Eddy made a motion to adopt the caucus by mail process, the motion was seconded. After discussion, Andre Green made a motion to call it to question, the motion was seconded by Marilyn Pettito Devaney, and the motion was passed. The Committee voted to adopt the caucus by mail process to elect district delegates to the National Convention.

The Chair then discussed New Business before the Committee. The Chair explained that the Rules Committee would meet prior to the May meeting to discuss rules for filling vacancies on the Committee, including a male ballot-elected seat in the First Essex and Middlesex district, for the Committee to vote on. Vacancies on the Committee would be filled at the August meeting.

The Chair recognized Nichole Mossalam, who made a motion to ask the Resolutions Committee to draft a resolution urging lawmakers to lower signature requirements for offices that require candidates to collect at least 1,000 signatures to be placed on the ballot. William Shemeth seconded the motion. Marilyn Pettito Devaney informed the committee that signatures are due to the Secretary of the Commonwealth on April 24, so a resolution must be passed prior to the May meeting.

The Chair then recognized Steve Grossman, who informed the Committee that the Committee may vote to suspend the rules due to the health crisis. Grossman then amended Mossalam's motion to suspend the rules to consider a resolution in support of lowering signature requirements. After debate, Sam Poulton moved to close debate and the motion was seconded by Adeline Bee, and debate was closed. The Committee voted to suspend the rules.

The Chair then recognized Nichole Mossalam who made a motion to adopt a resolution¹⁶ urging lawmakers to support An Act relating to ballot nominations during the state of emergency due to COVID-19, HD.4981. A motion was made to call to question, it was seconded, and the Committee voted to call the resolution to question. The resolution was passed 155 to 33.

The Chair then thanked the State Committee staff for their work planning and executing the meeting. The Chair recognized Jeremy Comeau to thank the volunteers who assisted committee members throughout the meeting.

The Chair recognized Robert Peters made a motion to refer to the Resolutions Committee a motion to urge lawmakers to implement a vote by mail program prior to the November 2020 election. The motion was seconded, and referred to the Resolutions Committee.

The Chair recognized David O'Brien, who made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded, and the meeting was adjourned.
