Democratic State Committee Meeting

May 16, 2020

Meeting Minutes

Massachusetts Democratic Party Chair Gus Bickford called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. The Chair reviewed the meeting agenda, which included electing Democratic National Committee members, Party Leader and Elected Official and at-large delegates to the Democratic National Convention, and voting on a resolutions package recommended for approval by the Resolutions Subcommittee.

Attendance was recorded via email check-in and the Chair dispensed with the roll call. The Chair reviewed the minutes from the April 4, 2020 Reorganization Meeting. There were no corrections to be made to the minutes.

The Chair discussed rescheduling upcoming Committee events, including the China Pearl Dinner and the Roosevelt Dinner. The Chair reviewed the Treasurer's Report and announced that Treasurer Rufus Gifford would be taking a leave of absence to join Vice President Joe Biden's campaign as deputy campaign manager.

The Chair recognized Gifford, who nominated Deputy Treasurer Kathy Gasperine to act as Treasurer during his absence. Sharon Stout seconded, and Gasperine was elected Treasurer. The Chair recognized Gasperine, who thanked the Committee and announced that former Governor Deval Patrick would receive the Roosevelt Award.

The Chair recognized Boston Mayor Marty Walsh to address the Committee. At the conclusion of Mayor Walsh's remarks, the Chair reviewed the process to elect members to the Democratic National Committee.

The Chair opened nominations for the two male DNC member seats and recognized Tina Poindexter to nominate Mel Poindexter, Kate Donaghue seconded. The Chair recognized Bill Eddy,

who nominated David O'Brien. Lucy Rivera and Mel Poindexter seconded. Hearing no other nominations, the Chair proceeded to nominations for the two female DNC member seats.

The Chair recognized Martina Jackson, who nominated Brenda Brathwaite. Patricia Deal seconded the nomination. The Chair recognized Sophia Jeffery, who nominated Karen Payne. Martina Jackson seconded. The Chair recognized Phil Johnston, who nominated Lesley Phillips. Carol Aloisi and Russ Ashton seconded.

A motion was made to close nominations, the motion was seconded, and passed. The Chair invited Brenda Brathwaite, Karen Payne, and Lesley Phillips to deliver remarks. At the conclusion of the candidates' remarks, the Chair reviewed the balloting process for the two female DNC member seats. The ballot was sent out at 10:46 a.m., members would have until 11:06 a.m. to cast up to two votes.

The Chair invited Mel Poindexter and David O'Brien to deliver remarks and they were elected by acclamation by the Committee. The Chair recognized outgoing DNC members Susan Thomson and Kate Donaghue, who addressed the Committee while balloting continued.

The Chair recognized Deb Kozikowski, who made a motion to amend rules III.C.3 and III.D.3 of the Delegate Selection Plan to allow the Biden and Sanders campaigns to file with the State Democratic Chair a list of all such candidates for PLEO and at-large delegate he or she has approved, as long as approval is given to exactly one name for every position to which the presidential candidate is entitled., and remove sections III.C.3.c and III.C.3.d to allow for the amended rules. Sam Poulton seconded the motion. Discussion ensued.

The Chair paused discussion at 11:15 a.m., and recognized Senator Elizabeth Warren to address the Committee. After Senator Warren's remarks, the Chair announced the results of the female DNC member election. Brenda Brathwaite and Karen Payne received a majority of votes and were elected to the DNC. Discussion on amendments to rules III.C.3 and III.D.3 of the Delegate Selection Plan resumed.

The Chair recognized Senator Becca Rausch, who motioned to call the question, Marsha Finklestein seconded, and the motion passed. The Chair sent ballots to the Committee via email at 11:50 a.m. Ballots would remain open until 12:05 p.m. During balloting, the Chair recognized Executive Director Veronica Martinez, who reviewed that spring's special elections.

At 12:05 p.m., balloting closed. The motion did not pass. The Chair recognized LizBeth DeSelm, who motioned to amend the Delegate Selection Plan to adopt a bifurcated ballot to elect PLEO and at-large delegates to the Democratic National Convention, where slots would be filled by supporters of the Biden and Sanders campaigns based on the candidates' respective statewide

results regardless of the status of Senator Sanders's campaign. Sam Poulton seconded the motion. Discussion ensued.

The Chair recognized Joe Kaplan, who motioned to call the question. LizBeth DeSelm seconded, and the question was called. The Committee voted in favor of bifurcating the ballot.

The Chair recognized candidates for PLEO delegates to speak for one minute each, beginning with candidates pledged to Vice President Biden.¹ The Chair next invited candidates who were originally pledged to Senator Sanders to deliver remarks.²

At the conclusion of PLEO delegate candidate speeches, the Chair distributed ballots via email to the Committee at 12:46 p.m., ballots would remain open until 1:06 p.m. While balloting occurred, the Chair invited subcommittee chairs to deliver reports.

Kate Donaghue delivered the Campaign Services Subcommittee report. She spoke about the phone banking efforts of the subcommittee throughout the special elections.

Holly Ryan delivered the LGBTQ+ Subcommittee report. She invited new members to join the subcommittee.

Cheryl Cummings delivered the Disability Outreach Subcommittee report. She spoke about the work the committee is doing to ensure that mail-in ballots are accessible.

Russ Ashton delivered the Senior Outreach Subcommittee report. He spoke of the importance of accommodating seniors in the pandemic response.

Senator Jamie Eldridge delivered the Public Policy Subcommittee report. He spoke about the work the committee has been doing to educate members on election security and immigration.

At 1:06 p.m. the Chair closed balloting to elect twelve PLEO delegates to the Democratic National Convention and announced the winners.³

The Chair then invited at-large delegate candidates to speak for one minute each, beginning with candidates pledged to Vice President Joe Biden.⁴ The Chair invited candidates originally pledged to Senator Sanders to deliver one-minute remarks.⁵

The Chair distributed ballots to the State Committee via email at 2:07 p.m., the ballot would remain open until 2:22 p.m. The Chair recognized Marianne Rutter and Alex Pratt to deliver the Resolutions Committee report. They reviewed the resolutions submitted to the subcommittee. The Resolutions recommended 8 resolutions for approval.⁶

The Chair recognized Michael Gilbreath, who moved to accept the resolutions report, the motion was seconded. The Chair recognized Rhonda Bourne, who motioned to separate the Platform in Action resolution from the resolutions package. Holly Ryan seconded the motion. Discussion ensued.

The Chair paused discussion to announce the winners of the at-large delegate election.⁷ Robert Cassidy and Thomas McGee received the same amount of votes, the Chair sent a ballot via email to resolve the tie, and Cassidy was elected delegate.

Discussion on the Platform in Action resolution resumed. The Chair recognized Nancy Stenberg, who motioned to call the question, the motion was seconded, and passed. The motion to separate the Platform in Action resolution was not passed.
